



THE DECISION SCIENCE JUNIOR RESEARCH CHAIR

The Decision Science Project is a joint venture between ENSAE, HEC, Ecole Polytechnique, and CNRS, which aims at enhancing collaborations between these institutions.

The Decision Science Project invites applications for a one-year Research Junior Chair position. Candidates should possess an internationally recognized record of publications with a concentration in one of the following areas: economics, finance, insurance, accounting, marketing, econometrics, statistics, or game theory.

The position entails no teaching duties and is not renewable. Candidates are expected to have a strong research programme involving research groups from at least two institutions among ENSAE, HEC and Ecole Polytechnique, and to run a joint regular seminar and a research activity within these groups.

Salary is in accordance with the collective agreement and experience. In addition a research budget provides good conditions for an active invitation policy. Applications including

- curriculum vitae,
- a research project,
- the names of three referees,
- an invitation letter from the hosting research groups from different institutions,

should be sent before April 31, 2009, to Pr. Marc Vanhuele, Director of the Decision Science Project, HEC...
