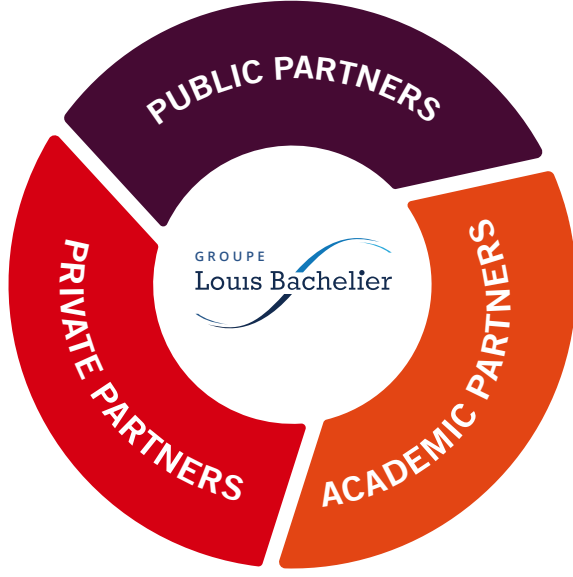

Finance, demographics, environment and the digital world. The 21st century is experiencing transitions that will have significant and lasting financial, economic, social and human impact. In the Louis Bachelier Network we explore the mechanisms driving these transitions and forecast their medium and long-term effects.

The Louis Bachelier Network is hosted by Institut Louis Bachelier, founded in 2008. Institut Louis Bachelier (ILB) draws on the resources of two foundations *Fondation du Risque* (FdR) and *Institut Europlace de Finance* (IEF) to support research programs and create new projects. More than 50 public-private-academic chairs and research initiatives are currently hosted under this umbrella .

Because we believe that these transitions, be they in finance, the digital economy, the environment or demographics, extend well beyond geographic borders, individual disciplines, and schools of thought, the Louis Bachelier Network's watchword is openness: innovative, interdisciplinary and global openness. Today this openness brings together over 400 researchers and some 85 companies and public organizations. Tomorrow we hope to be even more.

RESEARCH AREAS: THE FOUR MAIN SOCIETAL TRANSITIONS

FINANCIAL TRANSITION

Research in this area aims to support transformation in the banking and financial industries from the standpoint of stability and sustainability.

Research programs, publications and events have focused on topics such as: responsible finance, sustainable development, financial regulation and stability, financial risk, finance and behavioral economics, and innovation-based growth.

DIGITAL TRANSITION

Research in this area is designed to meet the challenges of digital transformation. First of all, it provides new mathematical and statistical approaches capable of analyzing information in a context where the sheer volume of data to handle initially seemed daunting. More generally, this focus area addresses the various economic issues generated by the democratization of new technologies.

Research programs, publications and events have focused on topics such as: AI, blockchain, big data, cyber-risk, and robo-advisory.

ENVIRONMENTAL TRANSITION

The goal here is to advance and promote the analysis and evaluation of existing and future public policy and economic instruments in the area of climate change.

Special emphasis is placed on using quantitative approaches and industrial economics to tackle environmental issues: climate economics, carbon and energy, exhaustible resources, and climate risk insurance in the agricultural, industrial and housing sectors.

Research programs, publications and events have focused on topics such as: climate change, non-renewable resources, circular economies, and CSR.

DEMOGRAPHIC TRANSITION

This focus area seeks to develop new public and private solutions for covering emerging risks pertaining to longevity, dependency, and health. It also aims to further our understanding of the impact these changes have on economic determinants: growth, productivity, financial markets, the accumulation strategy of human capital, etc.

Programs contribute to defining new social insurance channels and products, both public and private, suited to the various geographic, cultural and temporal situations stemming from demographic transition.

Research programs, publications and events have focused on topics such as: longevity and health, human capital, and the labor market.

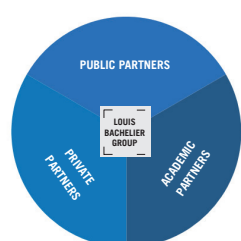

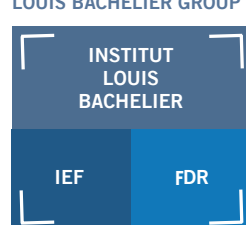


Louis Bachelier Network: a partnership-based network in economics and finance

The Louis Bachelier Network was created to stimulate knowledge exchange and cross-collaboration in support of sustainable development in economics and finance.

The network counts over 400 researchers, 85 private sector companies, public administrations and institutions, including la Direction Générale du Trésor (the French treasury department) and la Caisse des Dépôts which founded the Institut Louis Bachelier in 2008.

- The Finance and Insurance Reloaded interdisciplinary research program

These programs have clear European ambitions and will cooperate at the European level in order to propose explanations and solutions to societal issues on a larger-than-national scale.

Besides hosting and initiating research chairs, the Institut Louis Bachelier works to share, develop and promote scientific knowledge on issues relevant to our public, private and academic partners through a broad scope of activities.
