

Internship in Sustainable Finance at ILB - PARC

Paris Agreement Research Commons, a Louis Bachelier Foundation

The Institut Louis Bachelier is the leading partnership research network in economics and finance. It was created in 2008 by the Ministry of Finance to establish an ecosystem that brings together academics, businesses, and government authorities. Its mission is to amplify the impact of research and modeling in these fields.

The PARC Foundation (Paris Agreement Research Commons) is the latest of the 3 foundations within the Louis Bachelier group, launched in January 2024 under the auspices of the Treasury to develop interdisciplinary research programs and applied research in green and sustainable finance.

The PARC foundation completes a unique setup in the sustainable finance ecosystem, consisting of the Labs and the Sustainable Finance Observatory.

The ILB Labs consist of 30 data scientists and engineers with the objective of assisting companies in the financial sector in their digital and ecological transformations, in interaction with renowned researchers.

The Observatory is an initiative of ADEME hosted by PARC aiming to stimulate climate commitments from private actors in the financial sector, in France and worldwide.

Internship Objectives :

This internship may revolve around various themes, depending on the projects that will commence or be ongoing at the time of the intern's arrival. Under the direct responsibility of the PARC foundation's Managing Director and in coordination with ILB teams, the intern will be tasked with:

- Participating in the structuring and development of new interdisciplinary research programs on sustainable finance
- Participating in the organization and development of research networks, workshops, and conferences
- Contributing to the monitoring of research work and its orientation
- Conducting scientific monitoring on key themes (climate alignment, climate risk, impact, and biodiversity)
- Participating in applied research projects
- Reporting on the foundation's work

Technical Skills :

- Pursuing advanced studies in finance, Climate Sciences, or Engineering;
- Having knowledge of topics related to green and sustainable finance (Climate Sciences, ESG regulation, green and sustainable finance products/mechanisms...)

- Fluent in French and English (written and oral);
- Proficient in Microsoft Office (Excel, PowerPoint, Word), with presentation skills.

- Interested in working on innovative projects advancing the state of the art.

The position is located at Palais Brongniart in Paris (75002) with the possibility of part-time telecommuting. Remuneration is based on a scale (from 1400 to 2000 euros gross monthly with meal vouchers and reimbursement of 50% of the transport pass upon presentation of proof).
